MBT "AT-LARGE" APPLICATION (2022)

To be considered for an at-large berth, this application must be filled out completely and returned to the MBT offices along with the proper entry fee. At-Large berths will only be awarded if an **MBT State Tournament** has any openings. At-large applicants will be accepted <u>June 1st to June 20th</u> It is mandatory to include the proper entry fee, **payable to MBT**, with this application form. Entry fees will not be cashed for applicants who are not selected to play. Entry fee will not be cashed until the team is awarded an At-large berth. Teams who submit an At-Large application are expected to play. Teams WILL NOT be given the option to decline the berth or a refund issued if your team is awarded the At-Large berth. If your team qualifies at an MBT Qualifying Tournament, your At-large check will be transferred over to the Entry Form once we receive it from you. There is a \$150 Gate Fee paid directly to the Host Community at the time of Check-in before your first game.


The At-Large teams chosen based on:

- Tournament record.
- Tournament Placement in conjunction of other At-Large
- League Record in conjunction of others At-Large.
- There is no guarantee that you will be selected, just because you had your application in before others.

Once these factors have been considered the At-large team is contacted. They then will be emailed their MBT State Tournament roster/waiver form.
